



4060 Z SHOCK COMPATIBILITY

What size shock is compatible with the SCOR 4060 Z?

The SCOR 4060 Z is designed for a 210mm eye-to-eye shock with a shock stroke of 55mm for the LT configuration, and 47.5mm for the ST configuration.

Can I run a coil shock on the SCOR 4060 Z?

Absolutely. The SCOR 4060 and the 4060 Z are designed to be able to work equally well with either an air or coil shock, giving you the choice as to how you stay sprung. The frames are designed to accommodate coil shocks from Fox and RockShox, Öhlins and Ext will fit as well. Before buying a coil shock from another brand you'll want to check clearances.

Do I need additional hardware if I buy a SCOR 4060 Z frame and a compatible shock?

No, the mounting hardware is included when you buy a SCOR frameset without shock.
